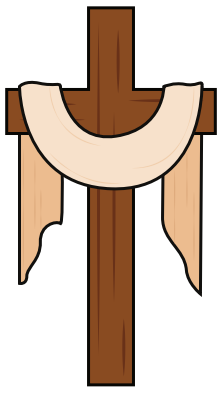

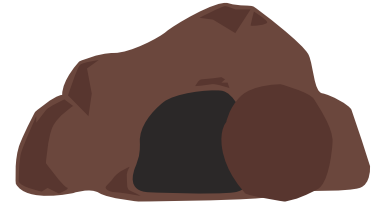

The churches in Strathaven are jointly bringing Searchlight Theatre group to the town to tell the story of the Rev John Harper who gave up his place on a lifeboat, on the night the Titanic sank, so that others may be saved. His daughter and niece, travelling with him survived.

By popular request, here is a summary of the 'Ichthus' method of prayer, from the sermon on 17th March....

Ichthus is the Greek word for fish, the secret Christian symbol amongst early Christians wary of persecution. In English, it stands for 'Jesus Christ Son of God Saviour'.

We can say these words as we breath in before we start praying.

We can also say 'Help me to hear Your voice'; as we breath out.

Try it several times before sitting quietly and listen to see if God has anything to say to your heart.

Then bring your own prayers before Him.
