Saturday 7th February

On Saturday 7th February, Philippa Hanna and her Band will be headlining "An evening with Philippa Hanna" in Avendale Church building. This is a Strathaven joint-churches event and the first date of her 2026 tour entitled "Til the Whole World knows".

Immediately prior to that, on 30th January, Philippa plans to release her first single for six years, on Spotify, also entitled "Til the Whole World Knows". It is amazing that Strathaven churches will be jointly hosting her first event of 2026. As expected, tickets for the event are already sold out.

Sunday 8th February

Separately, on Sunday 8th February Philippa and Joel will be joining us at our church service. They will both be taking an active part in leading the worship that morning (Ozma, their daughter, may help lead as well!). All are welcome to this service and it is an opportunity to invite friends and family who may enjoy her music and testimony.

Philippa is one of only a handful of full-time, female, Christian, singer-songwriters in the UK. She is a gifted poet, author and songwriter. She has a powerful testimony and is passionate about sharing the good news of Jesus Christ. She is practical about putting her faith into practice. As well as sponsoring children through Compassion UK she is also one of their ambassadors.

Recording and touring cost a significant sum of money. Philippa's income depends largely on ticket and merchandise sales, and faith that fellow Christians will support her ministry. She has not charged a specific fee for the Sunday morning involvement in our worship service.

There are various ways we may support her ministry. We can remember her and the band in prayer as they plan and prepare for events and services. We can share her songs and social media posts to broaden the impact of her message. We can also support them financially. We would like to give Philippa and Joel a financial gift from our church family to thank them for their involvement in the church service on Sunday 8th February and to encourage and support them in their role as they share the gospel throughout the UK. 
40 DAYS OF PRAYER
